# Summer School Overview

Summer school at Magic Years International School (MYIS) is a unique opportunity for your child to explore a range of "internationally-minded" engagements that support individual interests and development. It is also an opportunity for newcomers to Bangkok to meet other children during the quieter days of summer and become familiar with the school culture and routines before the start of the regular term. The program is open to children from all schools and those starting school for the first time.

### Programs offered:

### Ages 1-2 years:

A safe and nurturing environment is offered with rich sensorimotor experiences, hands-on learning activities, and challenging outdoor engagements. Through the care, emotional and physical comfort provided by an experienced early childhood educator, the children develop thinking skills, communication skills, and self-management skills while building secure and trusting relationships with their peers and teachers. A parent or a caregiver is encouraged to attend the class with the child.

### Ages 3-4 years:

Through an inquiry-based program, children have the opportunity to explore interest areas in the classrooms with a variety materials and manipulatives provide a variety and new challenges for the children. Children will engage in meeting times with games, singing and reading stories. There will also be time for free play in centers, outdoor play and a range of exciting specials classes. ### Ages 5-11 years:

For students ages 5-11, a balanced literacy program is offered to guide students toward proficient and lifelong reading and writing. Using a proven program, the key reading skills of fluency, comprehension, writing and vocabulary will be emphasized. Building on the IB PYP transdisciplinary framework, students will use modeled writing to independently draft creative writing pieces after which they will be invited to confidently present their work. # **LEGO®** Construction

#### with Bricks 4 Kidz

Bricks 4 Kidz is a popular children's edutainment program from the United States. During these classes, children will explore concepts from the field of architecture, engineering and technology using LEGO® bricks with a focus on exciting themes including space, inventions, famous buildings and natural disasters. The activities are designed to trigger young children's lively imaginations, enhance their problem-solving skills and build their confidence.



### Soccer

#### with CUKI TOTS

CUKI TOTS is a positive, entertaining pre-school football program delivered in a responsive and exciting environment. Instructed by FA qualified coaches and early years school teachers, the CUKI TOTS football program teaches fundamental football techniques and basic life skills through a variety of enthusiastic and energetic methods.



#### Cooking

Students will be given the opportunity to be independent chefs while developing a whole new sense and excitement for food as they engage in a number of different experiences in the kitchen. They will explore recipes, try new foods, use various kitchen equipment, engage in food preparation and create new dishes. Children will also learn to adopt safe and responsible practices in the kitchen and develop their fine motor skills in the process.



#### Art

Through art, students will be encouraged to enhance their power of expression in their own creative and unique ways. Children will be able to create, draw, paint, and sculpt the world they see, using their imagination and wonder. Children are provided with the space and time to explore and experiment different art techniques while developing their knowledge of art and craft practice.



### Gym

Activities in the gym help children become skillful, knowledgeable and expressive movers. The children will learn a variety of fundamental movement skills such as leaping, balancing, rolling, throwing and catching. Children will be encouraged to use their bodies to solve problems, tackle appropriate physical challenges, manipulate equipment or apparatus, and express themselves in a range of situations.



### Swimming

Swimming helps young children develop physically, mentally and emotionally and is a great opportunity for them to take risks and acquire an important life skill. With the supervision of an experienced instructor and the classroom teachers, the children will have the opportunity to learn to swim in a safe, fun and challenging environment.



### Thai Language

In Thai class, children learn Thai language through meaningful activities, games, stories and songs. The children learn to recognize the Thai alphabets, sounds and Thai numbers as they engage in a myriad of different themes related to Thai culture. Children will also have the opportunity to practice dot writing of the Thai alphabets and single words as well as learning to engage in short conversations and to ask questions in the Thai language.



### Woodworking

In Woodworking class, children learn how to handle tools such as a hammer, saw, screwdrivers, pliers, clamps and hand drills. Our woodworking instructors model proper behavior prior to using these tools. At the workbench, children learn how to nail pieces of wood together, sand and smooth a finished product. Safety and proper use of tools is emphasized in the class.

### **Program Structure**

Summer School consists of two sessions during the summer months of June and July for children ages 1 to 11 years old. Each session lasts three weeks.

# **Transportation Fee**

# **Registration Process**

Parents can register for summer school from March 26 – June 4, 2018. Due to the limited spaces available, we can only guarantee placement for students whose parents complete the payment and the Registration Contract. Parents are required to complete the Registration form and Field Trip Permission form. Non Magic Years students are required to complete the <u>enrollment application form</u>, Registration form, Field Trip Permission form, and Dismissal Authorization form.
